**Attention: Lessors of Crown Land**

After inspection of leased Crown Land it has come to our attention that the outdoor facilities on this property are not up to Environmental Standards. Bacteria from said facilities can travel a long way underground, into lakes, rivers and streams. With this leased land being located so close to the Madawaska Highlands Park, we have come to the conclusion that the outdoor facilities must be properly cleaned up and permanently closed. A sewage pump truck will have to be brought into help with the process of cleaning up the sewage. Afterwards the hole will have to be filled in.

You will either have to install a composting toilet or have correct plumbing and sewage facilities installed

You will have 30 days to have the work completed to the Ministry's Standards, afterwards a further inspection of said property will be done. If not completed within the 30 days, we will be required under the Environmental Protection Act to terminate your lease with no further delay.

*Environmental Protection Act, RSO, 1990.*

*"Despite any other provision of this Act or the regulations, no person shall discharge a contaminant or cause or permit the discharge of a contaminant into the natural environment that causes or is likely to cause an adverse effect".*
